Short Breaks provide children and young people with disabilities aged 0–17 years living in the Wokingham Borough, the opportunity to spend time away from parents and carers, relaxing and having fun with friends.

They also provide families with a break from their caring responsibilities. Short Break activities are offered during the daytime, evening, weekend, and school holidays.
