2020 – 2021 What have we done?

The last year has certainly been a year like no other!


- Continued to build our membership and have increase the number of families we contact by 20%
- We now have contact with over 1200+ families through email, social media and contacts with other local voluntary groups
- Continue to offer Max Cards to all our members
- Run more than 16 events for parent carers including 7 training sessions, drop-ins, consultations on the Ordinarily Available, Transport Policy & SEND Strategy Outcome Measures, and focus groups on the new EHCP template
- Produced a Covid-19 Guide for SEND families and keep our website updated
- Run surveys on the EHCP Process, Coproduction Charter, Home to School Transport, SEND DfE Conversation and Parents Experience Services during Covid Lockdown
- Produced a Local Offer Booklet (instead of our live event) which will be going out to over 1200+ families this month

2020 – 2021 What happened behind the scenes?

- Committee estimate 1000+ hours work for SVW
- In addition to this we are also involved with all aspects of the Ofsted/CQC Local Area Inspection & Written Statement of Action
 - 7 work streams and over 450 hours work a 80% increase in hours vs last year
- Total work by SVW equivalent to 5.5 days a week
- Continued work with the Berkshire West SEND Joint Implementation Group, DfE SEND Update, Short Breaks, SENDIASS Steering Group, SEND Providers Forum, WBC Operational Meetings, Healthwatch, EHCP Audits, Autism Strategy, ASD/ADHD Support Service commissioning, Mental Health Admission Avoidance and NNPCF Regional Cluster Group
