The last year has certainly been a year like no other! Who would have imagined that it would bring more lockdowns, home schooling, facemasks, and a whole new set of challenges for SEND families.

We continue to have regular contact with the Local Authority, Education, Social Care and Health teams during these difficult times and talk to them about the issues that families are raising.

Although we were not able to run many of our regular events and training in person, like everyone else we have adapted, moved things online where we can.

Highlights of our work last year:

- Continued to build our membership and have increase the number of families we contact by 20%
- We now have contact with over 1200+ families through email, social media, and contacts with other local voluntary groups
- Continue to offer Max Cards to all our members
- Ran more than 16 events for parent carers including 7 training sessions, drop-ins, consultations on the Ordinarily Available, Transport Policy & SEND Strategy Outcome Measures, and focus groups on the new EHCP template
- Ran surveys on the EHCP Process, Coproduction Charter, Home to School Transport, SEND DfE Conversation and Parents Experience Services during Covid Lockdown
- Produced a Local Offer Booklet (instead of our live event) which was sent out to over 1200+ families
- Represented families at the SEND Implementation Board (SIB) and the 6 work streams that resulted from the Local Area SEND Services Inspection in Wokingham and the resulting Written Statement of Action (WSoA)
- Produced a Covid-19 Guide for SEND families and kept our website updated with the ever-changing information

Like everyone our committee has had challenges to face over Due to home schooling and family the past year. commitments Helen Corbett and Aleca Rzysko were unable to continue as co-chiars, but we are pleased that they have remained involved in the work that we are doing. We also want to send a big thank you to Martin Jones, who has supported us for many years with all things financial, and has now stepped down.

We are very pleased to welcome Lynn Boba to the committee.

Although we are a small group of volunteers, we all believe in our children and their potential and know with the right provision they can achieve so much. We are passionate about improving services and experiences of our families, but we can only do this with your help. Please continue letting us know about your experiences, what is going well and where things can be improved.



Local Area Re-visit Inspection of SEND Services April 2021



A re-visit inspection to review the progress on the Written Statement of Action (WSoA) over the last 2 years took place in May 2021. Thank you to all the families who took time to respond to the Ofsted revisit survey. At the time of writing this we are still waiting to hear the result of the revisit but will share this information as soon as it is received.



Over the last year are involvement on the WSoA has added over 450 hours work to our workload – a 80% increase in hours vs the previous year.

There has been progress across several of the workstreams. For example, around 75% of EHCP applications are being issued within the 20-week timeframe (National figure is 60%), a Co-production Charter was signed by all partners, the 0-25 Wokingham wide SEND Strategy agreed and has now progressed to the SEND Innovation & Improvement Programme (IIP) for its roll-out. There is still a long way to go and as the programme of work moves from the WSoA two-year plan into the SEND IIP. SEND Voices Wokingham will continue to represent families on all the new workstreams.

Surveys, surveys, surveys.....Thank You for your feedback

A BIG thank you to all the parent carers who have completed surveys or consultations for us during 2020/21. We

know there have been a lot but without your feedback on these, we cannot tell Education, Health and Social Care what is working and what needs improving. The results of the surveys you completed last year have resulted in the following changes:

Coproduction Charter – A Wokingham area Coproduction Charter has been coproduced and partners WBC and Health have signed up to working in coproduction to puts the needs of the individual at the heart of all the decision-making processes and the support and services provided at all levels.



SEND DfE Conversation and Parents Experience Services during Covid Lockdown - This raised a number of issues around the EHCP Annual Reviews process. As a result, the Annual Review process is being reviewed and updated as part of the SEND Innovation & Improvement programme.

EHCP Process Survey — We continue to run this ongoing survey to ensure that quality of EHCP's is continually monitored and reviewed. The results will be used by the Innovation & Improvement group who are working to continually improve processes.

Home to School Transport – Feedback from parents has resulted in regular meetings with Corporate Transport & the SEND team to address the issues you raise. It has also informed the new Home to School Transport Policy which is being developed.

Please keep completing the surveys and consultations. The information they provide is so important and makes a real difference to improving services in the borough.
